In the project "Women Participation in Public Life", the RFMN was signed by the British Council in November 2012 (partnership agreement at our International Forum November 2012) to implement and reduplicate the program in Morocco for three years in favor of women leaders who have the ability to be agents of change as citizens actively involved at the local level while being aware of being globally connected.

A first group of women leaders from the region of associations Skhirat-Temara benefited from this training program from February 04th to February 07th, 2013 at Dar El Achabab Wifaq Temara - A group of 25 women representing 15 associations for a week -.

The program of «citizenship and participation of women in working life» training presented to beneficiaries four elements: cultural identity, social dialogue, study and analysis of community development & social action project. Its modules are intended to get to know and take ownership of the program, understand the importance of social dialogue to contribute to positive change while respecting difference and the point of view of the other, develop tools beneficiaries for better society and in their community, and then pass on their skills and know-how to develop social action projects.
