To be effective, MWM relies on members already involved in its activities, but also on new motivated women who are ready to share the values of the network. In this framework, the "Recruitment" Committee organizes regular recruitment activities to encourage other women to join the network. During the first quarter of 2012, the committee received a large number of resumes to be analyzed. After a selection based on specific

criteria, the committee called the candidates to arrange interviews. All committee members in Rabat and Casablanca participated in this process. At the end of the recruitment process, 15 new top women officially joined the network on february 25th, 2012 for the 3rd cohort. Through the efforts of the "Recruitment" committee, the network currently has 75 outstanding women.
